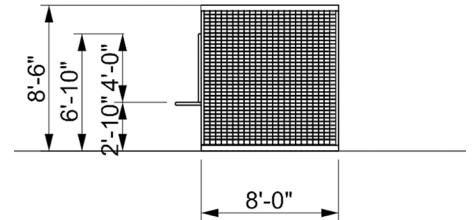
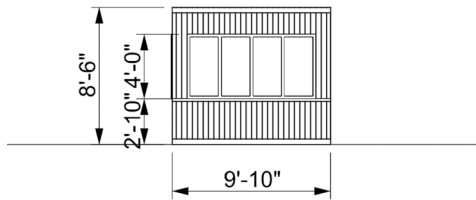
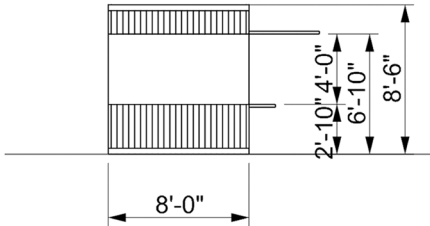
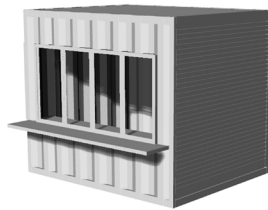
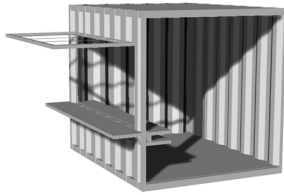




Welcome Center for Governors Island
